Additional Backup Information

The appellant, Mr. Cecil Ruby, is appealing the Building and Fire Code Board of Appeals decision to deny the appeal and uphold the approval and issuance of a building permit for a garage built at 3100 Highland Terrace West.

The Building and Fire Code Board of Appeals is a technical board and determines when a structure is compliant with the technical codes. The Board found that the residential structure/garage, as built, is compliant with the adopted *Residential Code*. The Board ruled to Deny the appeal with the understanding that the Stop Work Order remain in effect, with no work allowed to proceed, until the Building Official has reviewed the structural design and any other permit application questions that may arise during his review and decides it complies with the *Residential Code*.
