PROPOSAL

Demolish a ca. 1954 house.

ARCHITECTURE

One-story, rectangular-plan, side-gabled brick-veneered, ranch house with a recessed entry and casement windows.

RESEARCH

The house was built in 1954 by Jack Andrewartha, a local builder. The first owners and occupants were Albert and Fern Grossman, who lived here until the mid-1960s. Albert Grossman was an auditor for the State Health and Welfare Department; Fern Grossman was an administrator for the Social Security office. Robert Cash, a right-of-way appraiser for the State Highway Department, owned and occupied the house in the late 1960s and early 1970s. An associate professor at the University of Texas, Eddward J. Rhoads, was the owner and occupant in the late 1970s and early 1980s.

STAFF COMMENTS

The house is beyond the bounds of any City survey.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Release the permit upon the completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package, consisting of photographs of all elevations, a dimensioned sketch plan, and a narrative history, for archiving at the Austin History Center. The house has neither the architectural nor the historical significance to warrant individual designation as a historic landmark.
