
WHAT DOES A RESILIENT CITY MEAN?

Sudden shocks or accumulating stresses can lead to social & health challenges, environmental & infrastructure disruption, or economic decline.






Our ability to innovate — the process and practice of learning, creating, and applying — contributes to our ability to survive, adapt, and thrive in the face of adversity.
