Additional Backup Information

Greater Austin Transportation Company d.b.a. Yellow Cab Company has filed a taxicab franchise renewal application. The existing franchise expires on August 8, 2015. Austin Cab proposes to continue to operate 461 taxicabs to provide taxicab service to the entire city, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The application has been reviewed and all required information is on file with the Austin Transportation Department.

Yellow Cab Company, originally known as American Cab, has provided taxicab service in Austin since 1985 and has exhibited the character, experience, and ability to provide taxicab service. The Austin Transportation Department recommends approval of renewal of the taxicab franchise for a period ending 2025.

The City Charter requires a franchise renewal to be granted by ordinance and read at three regular City Council meetings. The third reading may not occur until 30 days after the first reading. Following is the schedule for the second and third readings:

Second reading – May 21, 2015 Third reading – June 4, 2015
