I write to update you on the status of our response to City Council Resolution 20141002-078. This resolution aimed at initiating an on-line reporting tool as part of the Repeat Offender Rental Registration Program.

The Austin Code Department has a dedicated webpage for the Repeat Offender Program. The page is publicly accessible and contains: information about the program, a link to the ordinance, an application form for offenders, list of properties registered in the program and an interactive map. The interactive map provides searchable data that includes: property type, address, number of buildings/units, license number, date registration was mailed, current status of the case and enforcement action.

The contract with Civic Industries for the on-line tool that will report the status of all code data has been executed. The implementation date is June 1, 2015.
