## Additional Backup Information

Neenah Avenue is approximately a 40 foot wide, two-lane roadway with bike lanes located within the full purpose jurisdiction of the City of Austin, Williamson County, Texas (See exhibits A&B).

In recent years, Neenah Avenue has experienced an increase in traffic volume due to residential and civic development in the area, including two private schools. To accommodate the increase in traffic volume, Williamson County has proposed to widen the roadway, at their expense, to provide no less than a 51 foot width roadway from Olive Hill Drive to approximately 1,500 feet east of Solera Drive. The south curb line of the roadway will be removed allowing the roadway to be widened. The 51 foot wide roadway will provide two (2) 10 foot wide lanes in each travel direction with an 11 foot wide center two-way left turn lane. In addition, the project will add an 8 foot wide shared use path to each side of the roadway. The improvements are being done to improve traffic flow through the project limits.

This project is managed by the Public Works Department.
