The contract is to provide 362kV circuit breakers for Austin Energy. Circuit breakers are devices that are opened to de-energize a high-voltage transmission line or portion of a substation for construction and maintenance or during fault or outage conditions. Circuit breakers are crucial for protecting Austin Energy crews and contractors, as well as expensive substation equipment. They function to contain electric service outages by minimizing the chance that upstream equipment in the system will be forced to clear the fault.

In Fiscal Year 2013, Austin Energy purchased four 362kV circuit breakers. In Fiscal Year 2014, Austin Energy purchased six 362kV circuit breakers. Under the new contract, Austin Energy expects to purchase five 362kV circuit breakers each year.

The current contract expired on May 4, 2015. Approval of this replacement contract is requested to minimize the lapse between contracts and ensure a reliable and timely source for obtaining circuit breakers.
