Additional Backup Information

The LES Burleson annexation area (approximately 13.2 acres) is located in southern Travis County south of Burleson Road, approximately 870 feet east of the intersection of Burleson Road and Smith School Road. This area is currently in the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) and is adjacent to the City's full purpose jurisdiction on the north and west sides of the tract. In 2011, the City entered into an annexation and development agreement with the property owner, called the Helen Boothe et al Annexation and Development Agreement. The Original Agreement established development regulations for the property and provided that it would remain in the ETJ for a period of 15 years if it continued to be used for agricultural purposes. The property owner is requesting termination of the Original Agreement and full purpose annexation.
