ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-5-28 OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO GENERAL CITIZEN COMMUNICATIONS AT COUNCIL MEETINGS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. City Code Section 2-5-28 is amended to read:

§ 2-5-28 GENERAL CITIZEN COMMUNICATION.

- (A) At a Thursday council meeting, a maximum of 10 people may address the council during the general citizen communication portion of the meeting.
- (B) A person who intends to speak during the general citizen communication must register between 9:00 a.m. on the 14th day before the council meeting at which the person intends to speak and 4:30 p.m. on the Thursday before the council meeting at which the person intends to speak.
- (C) The city clerk should not accept more than <u>10</u> [ten] registrations under this section for general citizen communications at a council meeting. [Except as provided in Subsection (E), the] <u>The</u> city clerk may not register a person to speak at general citizen communication more frequently than once out of every three regularly scheduled council meetings.
- (D) [Except as provided in Subsection (E), a] A person may not speak at general citizen communication more often than once out of every three regularly scheduled council meetings.
 - [(E) A person may speak more frequently than once out of every three regularly scheduled council meetings if, as of 4:30 p.m. on the Thursday before the council meeting at which the person intends to speak:
 - (1) fewer than 10 people are registered to speak at general citizens communication; and
 - (2) all of the remaining registration requests received by the city clerk are from people who have spoken within the past three regularly scheduled council meetings.]
- **PART 2.** This ordinance takes effect on 2015.
