SUBJECT: Approve an ordinance waiving or reimbursing fees for the 2015 Mother Earth Day Festival which was held Friday, May 8, 2015 at the Springs in Zilker Park.

CURRENT YEAR IMPACT:

ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The total amount of Parks and Recreation Department (PARC) fees for this event were \$1,520. This item reimburses \$400, leaving \$1,120 in fees that have not been waived or reimbursed for this event.

As outlined in Resolution No. 021003-40, the remaining FY 2015 Mayor and Council fee waiver budgets will be reduced upon approval of this item by the following Offices and amounts: Council Member Pool, \$100; Mayor Pro Tem Tovo, \$100; Council Member Renteria, \$100; and Mayor Adler, \$100. Any fee requirements above this total are the responsibility of the applicant.

Waiving fees for this event results in unrealized revenue for the General Fund, Parks and Recreation Department. Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
