PROPOSAL

Partial demolition of a ca. 1936 house.

ARCHITECTURE

One-story, rectangular-plan, side-gabled frame house with a partial-width, front-gabled independent porch on temporary wood posts; paired 1:1 fenestration with 3:1 decorative wood screens.

RESEARCH

The house appears to have been built around 1936 by W.C. Raschke, who lived here until around 1938. The house was then owned and occupied by Fred F. (Fritz) and Viola Raschke until around 1957. Fred F. Raschke had a career in various dairies in town, including Meyer's Cremery, Bryant's Creamery, and Oak Farms Dairy. From 1957 until around 1980, the house was owned and occupied by Marcus and Edra Hanson. Marcus Hanson was a truck driver for Southland Ice then Mrs. Johnson's Bakery, before going to work for Dr. Pepper, and finally the Coca-Cola Bottling Plant.


STAFF COMMENTS

The house does not appear in any City survey. The applicant proposes to remove both the front and back walls for a remodel and addition.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Request that the applicants reconsider their plans to modify the front of the house. While the house does not qualify as a historic landmark, it is representative of the early construction in the neighborhood, and every effort should be made to preserve the street façade of the house to the greatest extent possible. If the Commission votes to release the permit, then require a City of Austin Documentation Package, consisting of photographs of all elevations, a dimensioned sketch plan, and a narrative history, for archiving at the Austin History Center.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES:

Frederick (Fritz) and Viola Raschke (ca. 1936 – ca. 1957) Fred and Viola Raschke appear as the owners of this house in the 1940 U.S. Census. The house was worth \$3,000, and is listed as 608 E. 49th Street. Fred Raschke was 38, had been born in Texas, and was a milk superintendent at a dairy. Viola Raschke was 39, had been born

in Texas, and had no occupation listed. They had 3 children: Helen Lynette, 16; Leroy, 14; and Raymond, 10. All the children had been born in Texas.

The 1930 U.S. Census shows Fred and Viola Raschke renting the house at 1411 Willow Street in Austin, with their 3 children. Fred Raschke is listed as a laborer in a creamery.
