PROPOSAL

Demolish a ca. 1953 house.

ARCHITECTURE

One-story, rectangular-plan, side-gabled frame house with a partial-width inset porch; glass block accents; single 1:1 fenestration.

RESEARCH


The house was built in 1953 for Wendell and Opal Morrow by Coy Dobbins, the proprietor of the Dobbins Lumber Company on Barton Springs Road. Wendell Morrow was a student when he and Opal built this house; Opal worked as an administrative assistant at the University of Texas. Wendell then taught in the public schools, was employed by the IRS, and was a civil engineer at Bergstrom Air Force Base. Opal Morrow continued to work as an executive assistant at the University of Texas. Opal Morrow died in 1981; it appears that Wendell Morrow moved out of this house shortly thereafter; he died in 1989.

STAFF COMMENTS

The house is not listed in any City survey. It was listed as contributing to the proposed Bluebonnet Hills Historic District, but more recent re-evaluations of the status of houses within the district will likely result in a staff recommendation that this house does not contribute to the historic character of the district due to its age and having been built after the period of significance for the district.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Encourage the owner to reconsider demolition of the house in favor of constructing an addition and adaptive re-use; while the house is not contributing to the historic character of the district, it is of a style and scale that is compatible with the district. However, the house does not qualify as a historic landmark, so staff recommends consideration of relocation over demolition, and in either event, release of the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package, consisting of photographs of all elevations, a dimensioned sketch plan, and a narrative history, for archiving at the Austin History Center.
