### Subject

Authorize execution of two 24-month contracts with TECHLINE PIPE LP for the purchase of hydrant repair parts and hoses for Austin Water, in an amount not to exceed \$149,518, with two 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$74,759 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$299,036; and with AAA FIRE & SAFETY EQUIPMENT CO., INC. in an amount not to exceed \$13,710, with two 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$6,855 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$27,420.

# Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$6,801 is available in the Fiscal Year 2014 – 2015 Operating Budget of Austin Water. Funds for the remaining 23-months of the initial contract period and extension options are contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

The parts will be used by maintenance crews for the repair of existing hydrants throughout the City.
