

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the City Council was requested to conduct a public hearing to consider the use of parkland for a permanent above ground pedestrian walkway and temporary working space to construct, use, maintain, repair, and replace an above ground pedestrian walkway through dedicated parkland known as the Waller Creek Greenbelt, located over Red River Street between the Austin Convention Center and the Fairmont Hotel (the “Proposed Use”); and

WHEREAS, the land being used for the Proposed Use is described in Exhibits A and B (the “Affected Land”); and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing to be held on August 20, 2015 was given for three consecutive weeks on July 26, August 2, and August 9, 2015, in a newspaper of general circulation; and

WHEREAS, such public hearing was held August 20, 2015, by the City Council to consider the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Having taken into account clearly enunciated local preferences, the City Council finds that there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use and that all reasonable planning has been done to minimize harm to the Affected Land from the Proposed Use. The use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use is approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The City Manager is authorized to take such measures as may be necessary, favorable, or required to effectuate the purpose and intent of this resolution.
