APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Approve the minutes of the Public Utilities Committee meeting of May 20, 2015.

5. Staff briefing, invited testimony, and policy discussion to consider a resolution to accept the approved connection tap plan at 10713 North FM 620 as a permanent service installation.

The committee did not make a motion but made the recommendation for staff to work with the property owner in reference to an agreement that contains the three points that were discussed during the meeting.
