AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2013-2014 CAPITAL BUDGET (ORDINANCE NO. 20130909-002) TO CREATE THE RAINEY STREET DISTRICT FUND AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO REHABILITATE EXISTING SINGLE-FAMILY STRUCTURES THAT ARE RELOCATED OUTSIDE OF THE RAINEY STREET DISTRICT AND TO PRESERVE THE HISTORY OF THE RAINEY STREET DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council finds that:

- (1) Austin is dedicated to preserving and creating affordable housing through principles and goals as outlined in the Imagine Austin Comprehensive Plan and many resolutions and ordinances directed to address the growing lack of affordable housing options in the city;
- (2) A key component of achieving the city's goal is promoting long-term affordability, as specified in the Imagine Austin Priority Program #6 "Develop and maintain household affordability throughout Austin";
- (3) The Rainey Street Subdistrict has several redevelopment projects underway and more are anticipated;
- (4) As redevelopment occurs, houses in the Rainey Street Subdistrict are no longer needed;
- (5) Relocation permits have been granted for six houses in the District and it is likely that similar requests will be made for the remaining structures;
- (6) The reuse of relocated structures for affordable housing will help the City address its affordable housing needs;
- (7) Rainey Street is a recognized National Register Historic District; and
- (8) The City is dedicated to preserving and maintaining the history of Rainey Street.
- **PART 2.** The Council amends Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Capital Budget (Ordinance No. 20130909-002) to create the Rainey Street District Fund (Fund).
