

HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING MONDAY, AUGUST 24, 2015

The Human Rights Commission convened in a regular meeting on Monday, August 24, 2015 at 301 West Second Street in Austin, Texas.

Chair Sareta Davis called the Board Meeting to order at 5:31 p.m.
