Amendment: C20-2015-015 Short-Term Rentals Type 2 License Suspension

<u>Description:</u> Consider an amendment to Title 25 of the City Code to suspend the issuance of new short-term rental Type 2 licenses.

 - o lake Austin residence (LA)
 - o rural residence (RR)
 - o single-family residence large lot (SF-1)
 - o single-family residence standard lot (SF-2)
 - o family residence (SF-3)
 - o single-family residence small lot (SF-4A)
 - o single-family residence condominium site (SF-4B)
 - o urban family residence (SF-5)
 - o townhouse and condominium residence (SF-6)
 - o multifamily residence limited density (MF-1)
 - o multifamily residence low density (MF-2)
 - o multifamily residence medium density (MF-3)
 - o multifamily residence moderate-high density (MF-4)
 - o multifamily residence high density (MF-5)
 - o multifamily residence highest density (MF-6)
- Does not apply to renewal of previously-issued licenses.

Background: Initiated by Council Resolution on September 17, 2015.

On September 17, 2015, Council initiated a code amendment to suspend the issuance of short-term rental Type 2 licenses, with the intent to revisit the effectiveness of the proposed license suspension at the end of 2016.
