Prior Council Action:	October 15, 2015 - City Council set public hearings to consider ordinances establishing Homestead Preservation Districts B, C, and D for November 19, 2015.  June 4, 2015 - City Council approved Resolution 20150604-051 related to the use of homestead preservation districts and homestead preservation reinvestments zones to address affordable housing issues in Austin, on a 9-0 vote.  May 27, 2015 - Council Housing & Community Development Committee voted to move forward a recommendation to the full Council to proceed with establishing homestead preservation districts and to direct the City Manager to develop a work plan and timeline to create a homestead preservation district tax increment reinvestment zone in Homestead Preservation District A, on a 4-0 vote.  Feb. 13, 2014 – City Council approved Resolution 20140213-044 directing the City Manager to develop a financing and funding plan for homestead preservation districts and determine criteria for designating whether land is unproductive, underdeveloped, or blighted, on a 7-0 vote.  June 27, 2013 – City Council approved Resolution 20130627-072 directing the City Manager to analyze the impacts of HB 3350 and present necessary City Code amendments so that homestead preservation districts can be created as soon as possible, on a 7-0 vote.
