Authorize execution of a contract with CENTRAL ROAD AND UTILITY, LTD. to construct a wastewater line for the Lockheed Lift Station Relief project in the amount of \$394,901 plus a \$19,745.05 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$414,646.05.

Additional Backup Information

This project decommissions a lift station constructed in 1999, located along Rusty Drive south of the intersection of US Highway 183 and Texas State Highway 71. Since its construction, new wastewater infrastructure has been installed south of the lift station in conjunction with this area's development. As part of the lift station's decommissioning, the wastewater flow that the lift station handled will be re-routed to the development's new wastewater infrastructure. The project will install 1,150 linear feet of 8-inch diameter wastewater line. The decommissioning of the outdated and failing pump station will improve overall system reliability and eliminate the expense of maintaining this lift station.

This project removes an outdated and failing pump station and a delay in the project may result in the continued expense of maintaining the Lockheed lift station.

This project is being built within an easement on privately owned property. The easements were acquired from the property owner, Met Center NYCTEX, LTD. The site is primarily industrial and therefore will not impact the public.

Due to the potential for encountering unknown conditions, a 5% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any change orders. A contingency is an additional amount of money added to the

construction budget to cover any unforeseen construction costs associated with the project.

The contract allows 180 calendar days for completion of this project. This project is located within zip code 78744 (District 2). The project will be managed by the Public Works Department.
