

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2007, the City Council (City) enacted Ordinance No. 20071018-008 electing to participate in the Texas Enterprise Zone Program (Program) authorized by the Texas Enterprise Zone Act (Act). The City subsequently enacted Ordinance No. 20101104-046 amending the Program on November 4, 2010. The local economic development incentives available in the City are the same on this date as those outlined in Ordinance 20071018-008, as amended by Ordinance No. 20101104-046; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Economic Development and Tourism (Governor's Office) through the Economic Development Bank will consider the project proposed by Freescale Semiconductor, Inc. (Freescale) as an enterprise zone project pursuant to a nomination and an application made by the City; and

WHEREAS, the project is located in an area designated as an enterprise zone; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to create the proper economic and social environment to induce the investment of private resources in productive business enterprises located in severely distressed areas of the City and to provide employment to residents in such areas; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, Freescale has applied to the City for designation as an enterprise zone project; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that Freescale meets the criteria for an enterprise zone project as required by the Act based on the following factors:

1. Freescale is a “qualified business” under the Act because it will be engaged in the active conduct of a trade or business at a qualified business site within the governing body’s jurisdiction located inside of an enterprise zone and at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the business’ new employees will be residents of an enterprise zone or economically disadvantaged individuals, or veterans; and
2. There has been and will continue to be a high level of cooperation between public, private, and neighborhood entities in the area; and
3. The designation of Freescale as an enterprise zone project will contribute significantly to the achievement of the plans of the City for development and revitalization of the area.

WHEREAS, the City will provide a single point of contact for the purpose of assisting with permitting and inspection for the Freescale expansion; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City to nominate Freescale as an enterprise zone project pursuant to the Act; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

1. The above recitals are adopted as findings of the City Council.

2. The City Council nominates Freescale to the Governor's Office of Economic Development and Tourism Division, through the Economic Development Bank, as an enterprise zone project that shall take effect on the date of designation of the enterprise zone project by the Governor's Office of Economic Development and Tourism Division and terminate five (5) years after the date of designation.
