








## Zilker Park Boat Rental Location

## Zilker Park Boat Rental Contract Overview


#### **Zilker Park Boat Rental**

- Howard Barnet, owner, started the concession in 1969 and was the first water-based recreation concession on Town Lake
- Current contract signed March 1, 2006
  - 5-year primary term
- 1st Option executed 2011 to 2016 (5-years)
- Final Option 2016 to 2021 (5-years)





## Zilker Park Boat Rental Boat Inventory



- Total canoes: 70
  Represents 66% of total canoe rentals on lake
- Kayaks: 78
  Represents 18% of total kayak rental on lake
- SUPs: 16
  Represents 3% of SUPs on the lake

## Zilker Park Boat Rental Additional Public Benefit

- Non-profit/community engagement: Zilker Park Boat Rental provides significant support for the community through pro bono and reduced rental fees for nonprofits. Last year ZPBR donated \$11,745 worth of free or reduced rentals to nonprofits and organizations such as:
  - PARD Recreation Centers, Austin Nature Center, Austin Youth River Watch, Keep Austin Beautiful, Big Brother/Big Sisters, Safe Place, and Austin Youth Works
- <u>Capital Improvements</u>: Zilker Park Boat Rental funded and constructed stone steps that traverse the bank from the concession to the parking lot, cost ~\$12,000
- <u>City Investment</u>: Zilker Park Boat Rental is in compliance with the contract terms and has always conducted business with no support from the City including flood recovery and restoration of the concession area
- <u>Proposed Improvements</u>: Zilker Park Boat Rental is working with the City of Austin's Watershed Department to provide \$18,000 in funding for a demonstration creek bank restoration project or provide equal funding to planning for the north shore of Barton Creek
- <u>Planning:</u> Planning is currently underway in Zilker Park that may influence the general area occupied by the facility. Therefore, it is beneficial to extend the agreement as a new contractor may propose improvements in conflict with future riparian zone planning.
