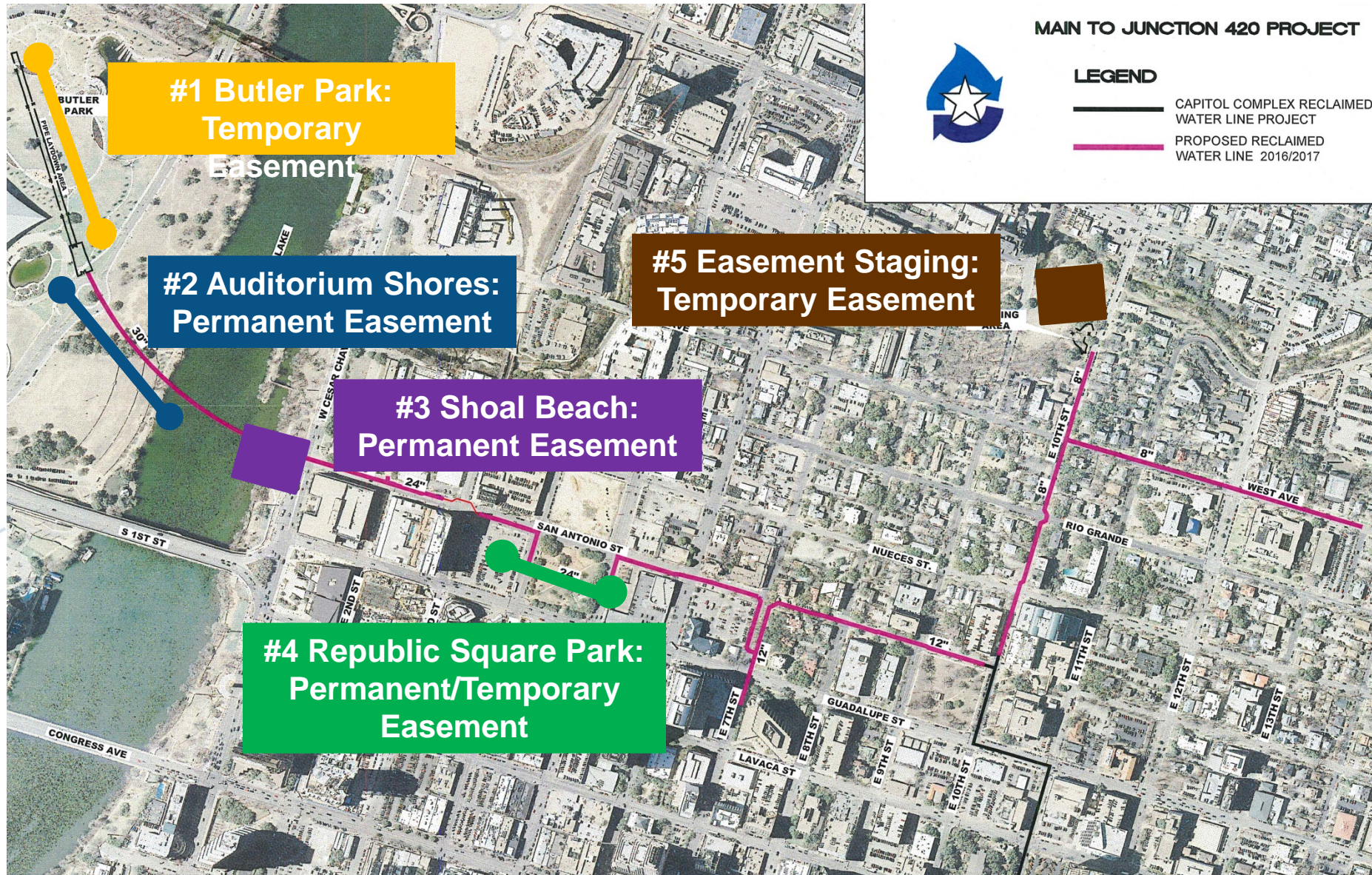

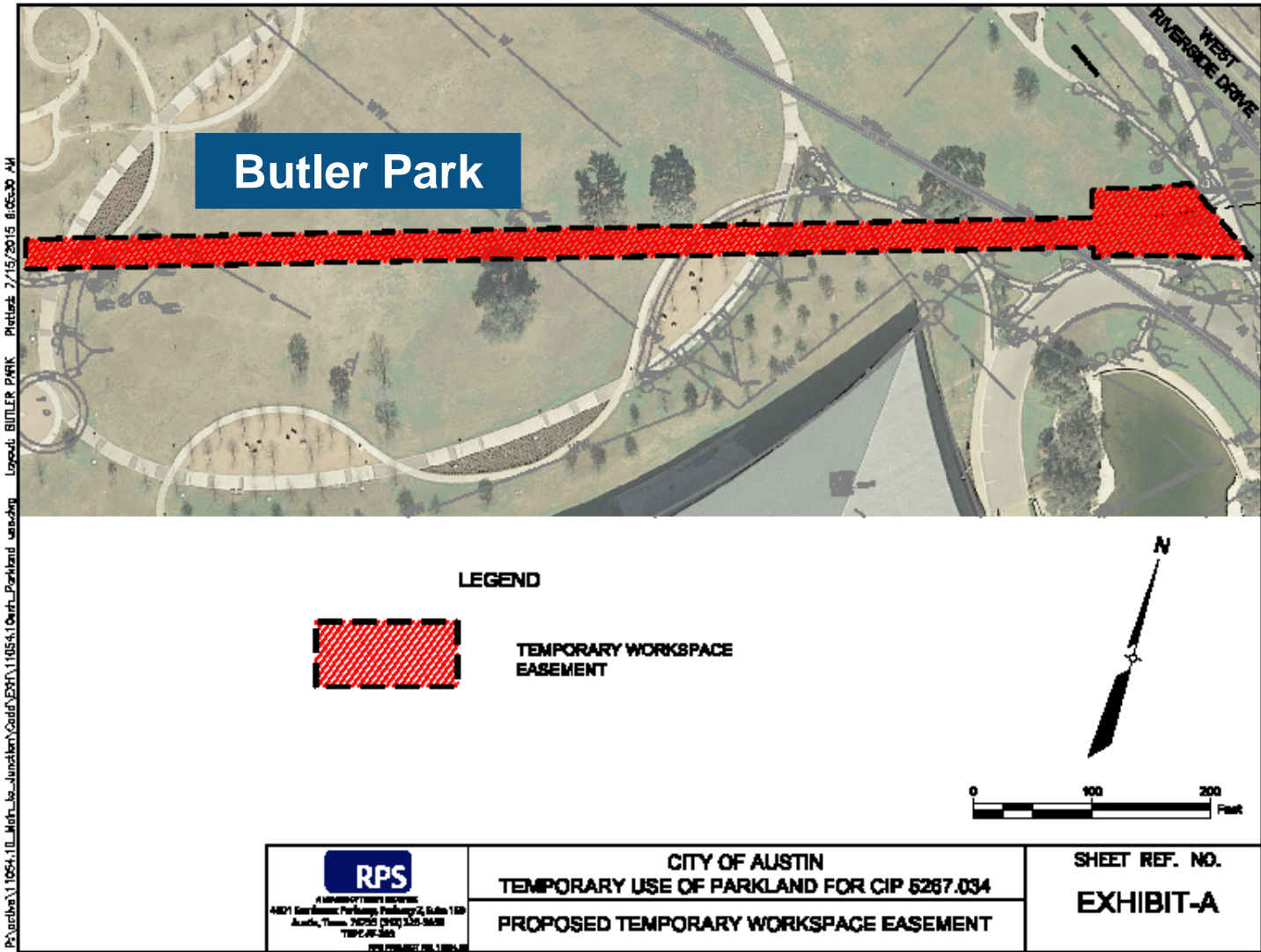

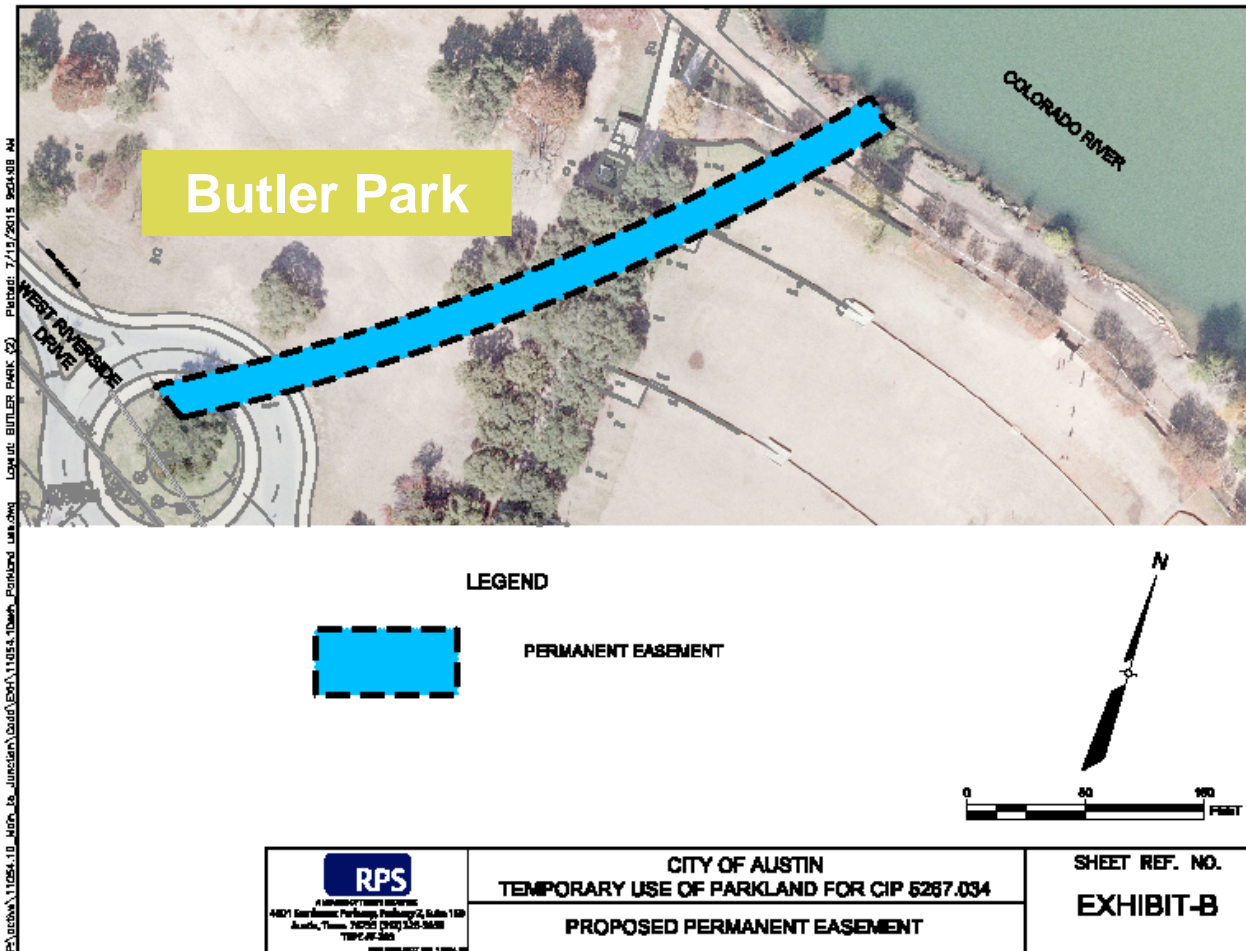

PROJECT DETAILS

- Request Approval for temporary use for a duration of 45 days.
- Tree protection will be in place during construction.
- Park access will be obstructed in the fenced 28,895 square foot laydown staging area to be used for Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD).
- This area is needed to set up and drill, and assemble two strings of pipe and pull.
- Land to be restored to existing condition or better.

Auditorium Shores at Town Lake Permanent Easement

PROJECT DETAILS

- Request Approval for permanent use for a 30-inch DR-9 HDPE Pipe that will be subterranean (deep underground).
- Tree protection will not be necessary; no trees in this area and there will be no disturbance of the surface.

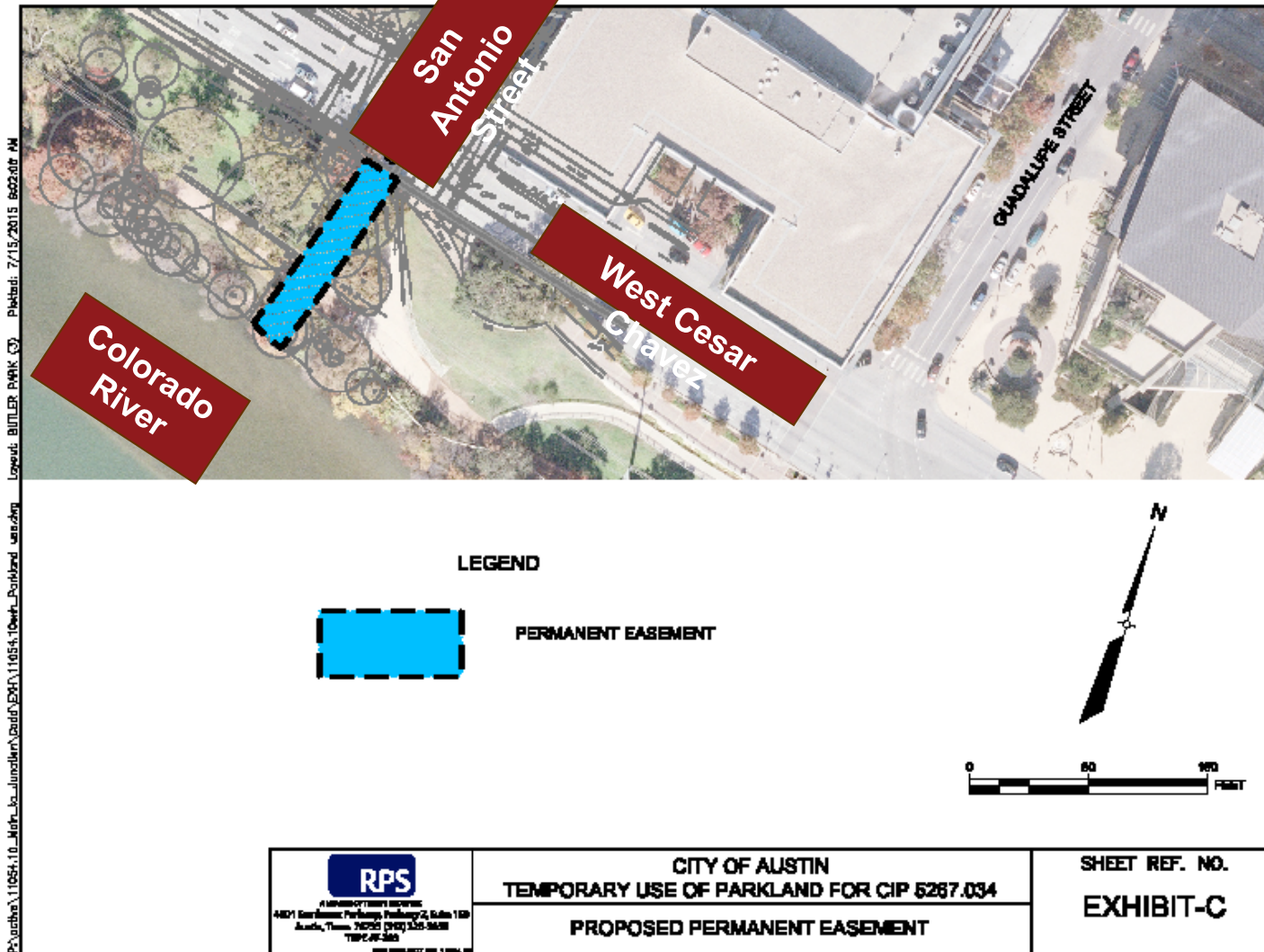


Shoal Beach at Town Lake Park Permanent Easement

Shoal Beach Permanent Easement

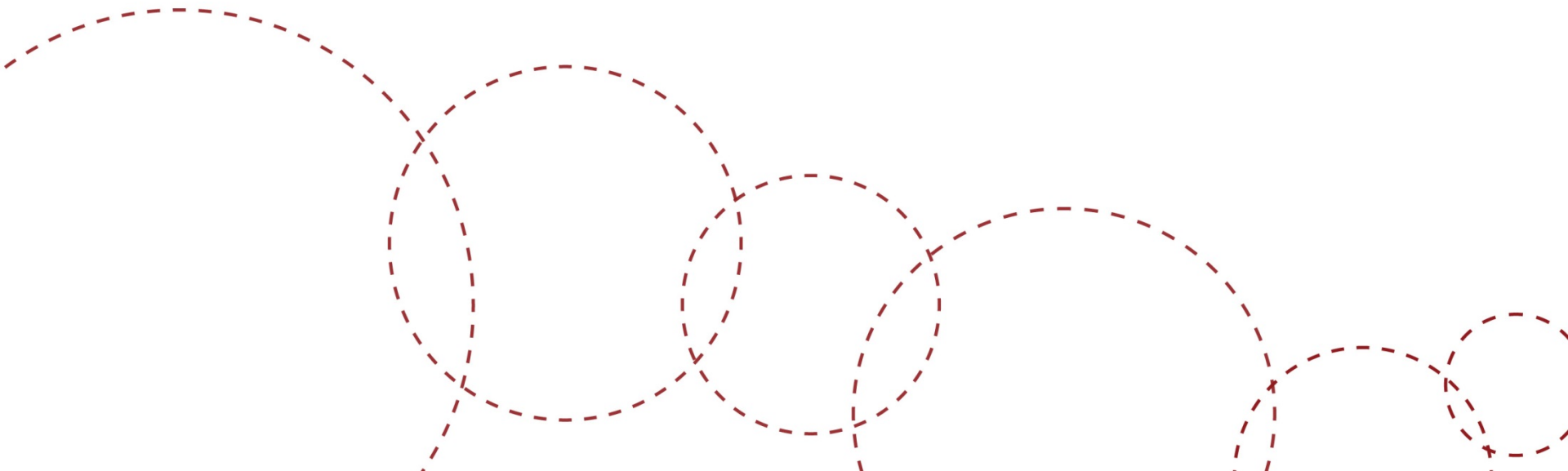

PROJECT DETAILS

- Request Approval for permanent use for a 30-inch DR-9 HDPE Pipe.
- Tree protection will not be required because there will be no disturbance of the surface.
- This area is needed for permanent pipe alignment.

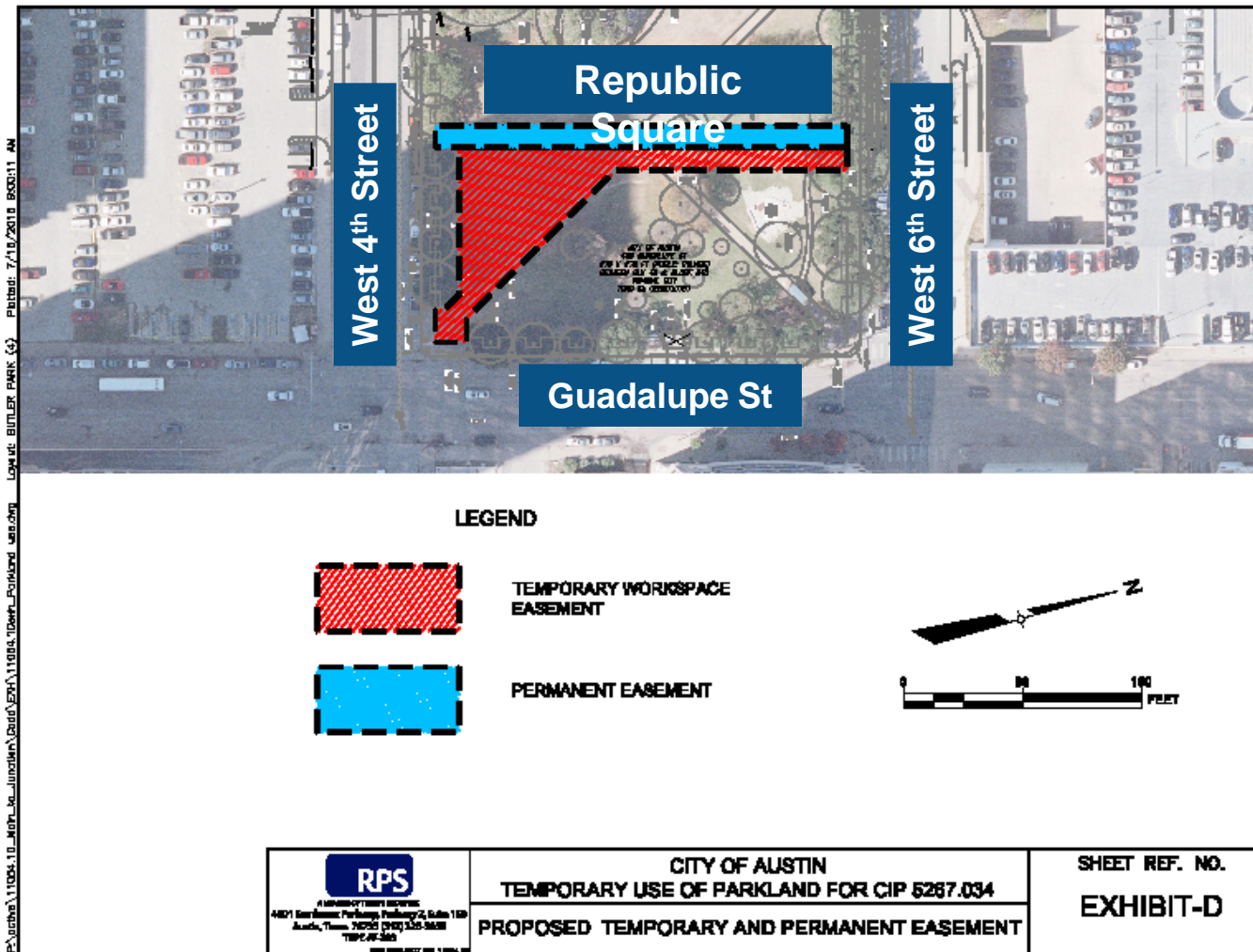

TEMPORARY/PERMANENT EASEMENTS



TEMPORARY EASEMENT

- Request Approval for temporary use for a duration of 45 days.
- Tree protection will be in place during construction.
- Park access will be obstructed by PARD performing the park renovation. The 9,941 square foot laydown staging area will be in the PARD construction area behind the PARD fence.
- This area was selected as the last option to use because of all the utilities in the street and the restriction of the former San Antonio Street.

PERMANENT EASEMENT

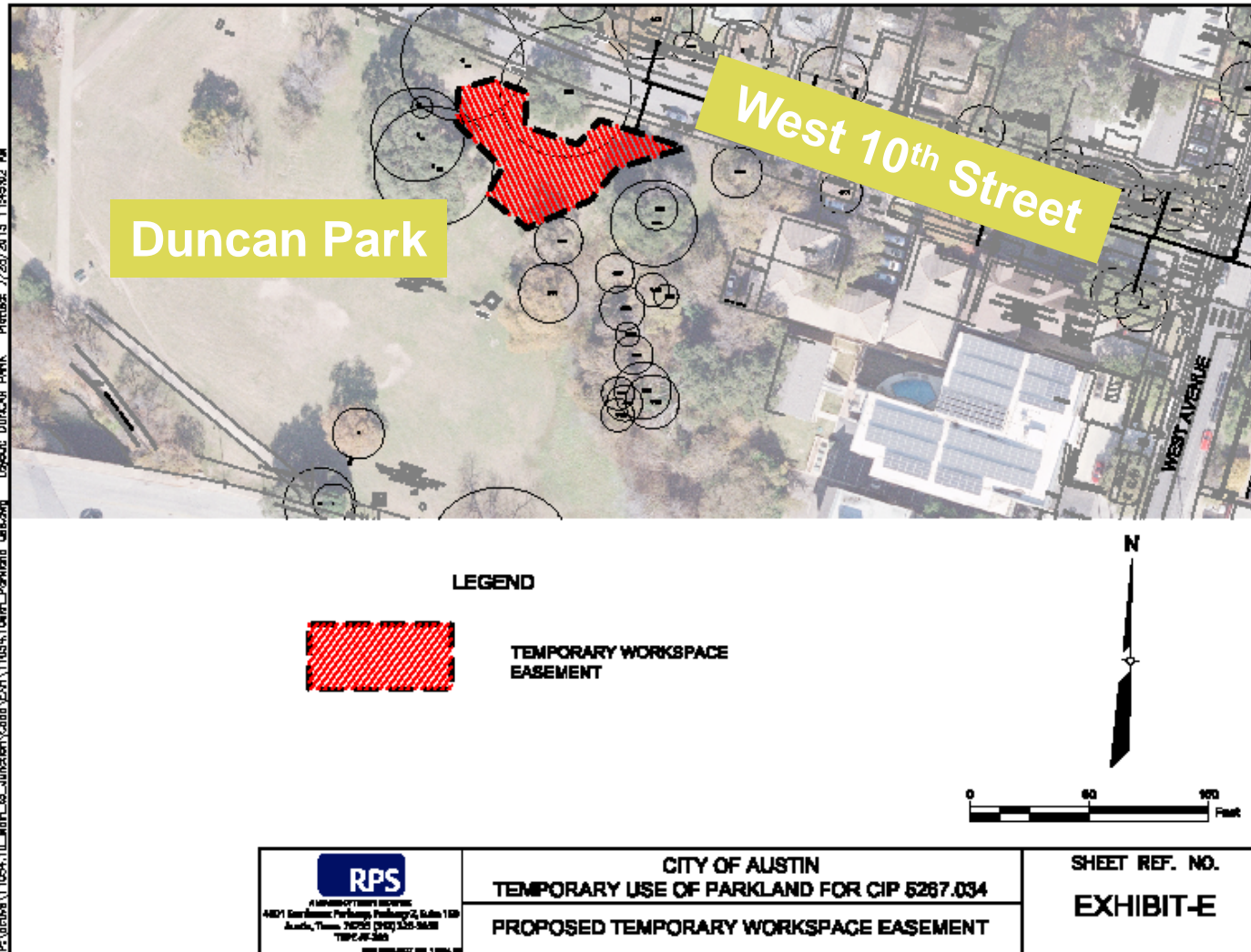
- Request Approval for a permanent easement for placement of a 24-inch Ductile Iron pipe in a 30-Inch Steel Encasement Pipe.
- Tree protection will be in place during construction.
- Park access will be obstructed in the fenced staging area, however the work will coincide with the reconstruction of the park by PARD.
- This area will be open cut where there are no trees. Trenchless methods will be utilized underneath trees along the alignment.




Duncan Park Temporary Easement

PROJECT DETAILS

- Request Approval for temporary use for a duration of 390 days.
 - Tree protection will be in place during construction.
 - Park access will be obstructed in the fenced 6,502 square foot laydown staging area to be used for construction materials.
 - Land to be restored to existing condition or better.

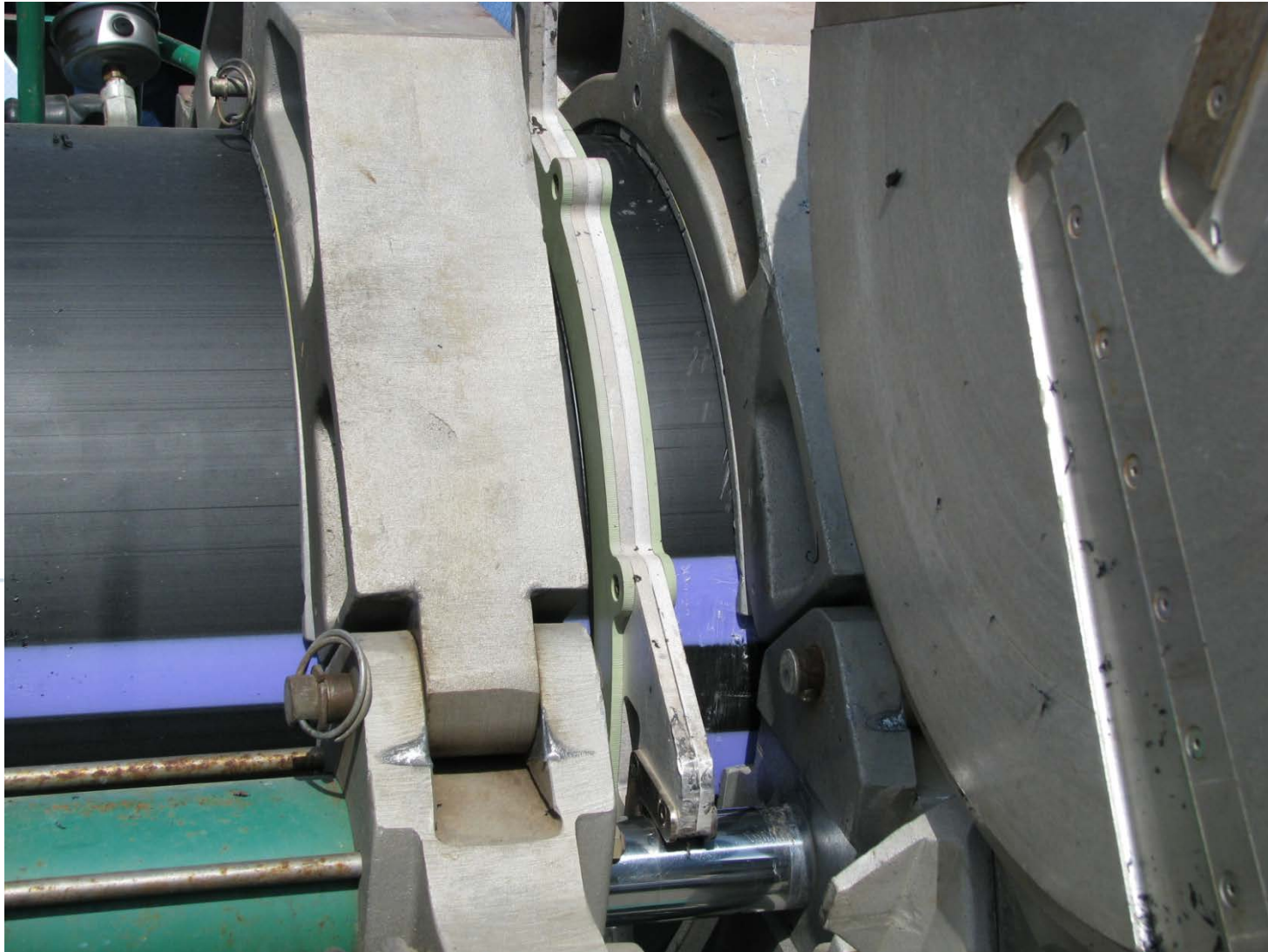
