SPECIAL CALLED MEETING - MAY 6, 1991
CANVASSING MAY 4, 1991 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Mayor Cooke called to order the special called meeting of the Council, noting the absence of Mayor Pro Tem Urdy and Councilmember Epstein. Mayor Cooke announced the purpose of the meeting was to consider a resolution canvassing the returns and declaring the results of the May 4, 1991 General Municipal Election and to consider an ordinance calling a run-off election for Saturday, May 18, 1991.

Motion

Motion

The Council, on Councilmember Carl-Mitchell's motion, Mayor Cooke's second, waived the requirement for three readings and finally passed an ordinance calling a run-off election for Saturday, May 18, 1991. (5-0 Vote, Mayor Pro Tem Urdy and Councilmember Epstein absent.)
