



Austin City Council MINUTES

**June 28, 1991 - 4:00 P.M.
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING**

Mayor Todd called to order the special called meeting of the Council, noting the absence of Councilmembers Epstein and Reynolds. Mayor Todd announced the purpose of the meeting was to go into executive session pursuant to Article 6252-17, Texas Revised Civil Statutes Annotated, to discuss matters of land acquisition, litigation and for personnel matters. Mr. Lessard shall assume all duties, power and responsibilities set forth in the City Charter, local and state laws; furthermore this motion contemplates that the present Municipal Court Clerk shall relinquish all responsibilities, powers and duties of that position to Joseph Lessard, effective immediately upon passage of this motion. (5-0 Vote, Councilmembers Epstein and Reynolds absent.)
