Mayor Cooke called to order the meeting of the City Council Legislative Sub-Committee held January 25, 1991 at 11:00 A.M. in the Conference Room 300 of the Municipal Building, 124 West 8th Street. Mayor Cooke noted the presence of Councilmembers Barnstone, Carl-Mitchell and Epstein.

The Mayor announced the purpose of the meeting was: Discussion of the legislative program for the 72nd regular session of the Texas Legislature and other state and federal legislative issues.

 - a. Status report on legislation for which the City of Austin will seek introduction and passage.
 - b. Report on bills filed with major impact on the City of Austin.

Members of the Legislative Sub-Committee discussed House Bill 373 regarding an airport authority and H.B. 374 regarding Bergstrom Air Force Base. Also discussed were health issues and legislation concerning water quality.
