## Additional Backup Information

The Office of Real Estate Services (ORES) administered an Invitation for Sealed Bids for the purchase of a commercial property owned by the City of Austin, located at 4711 Winnebago Lane. A third-party, independent appraisal was conducted to determine the fair market value of this property. The property was advertised, per the Texas Local Government Code.

All City Departments were informed of the sale of this property, and ORES requested notification of any short or long-term need that the City may have for the property. All City departments are currently in agreement with the sale.
