These contracts amend the term of existing natural gas transportation agreements with Atmos Pipeline – Texas, a division of Atmos Energy Corporation ("Atmos"), under which Atmos provides transportation services for natural gas supply to Austin Energy's gas-powered generating facilities. Atmos provides one of three pipelines connected to the Sand Hill Energy Center and one of two pipelines connected to the Decker Creek Power Station. The transportation agreements allow Austin Energy to access gas supply basins located along the Atmos Pipeline – Texas natural gas pipeline system. Service is needed from multiple pipelines for improved reliability, enhanced competition and broader access to natural gas supplies.

The current contracts expire December 31, 2015. The amendments extend the term of the agreements for 36 months to December 31, 2018.
