Summary of Discussion

Committee members discussed a motion brought forward by Council Member Casar regarding a recommendation to Council to stipulate that funds should be spent strategically in gentrified areas, gentrifying areas, and areas expected to gentrify. The motion further stipulates that funds should not be utilized in areas where concentrated poverty is expected to persist.

Direction
