Additional Backup Information

This action amends the Austin Housing Finance Corporation Grant Operating Budget and Housing Assistance Fund Budget to appropriate available cash funds to the HOME grant fund in the amount of \$1,391,143.52 and \$800,000 to the Housing Assistance Fund. These funds were derived from carry-forward funds (\$1,391,143.52) and the sale of future cash flows (\$800,000).

The Austin City Council created the AHFC in 1979 as a public non-profit corporation to facilitate the financing and development of affordable housing for low- and moderate-income residents. In addition to administering singlefamily and multi-family bond programs, the AHFC administers nearly all of the City's affordable housing programs. For FY 2015-2016, the AHFC will administer the Renter Assistance Program, the Homebuyer Assistance Program, the Homeowner Assistance Program, and the Housing Developer Assistance Program.
