

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the City Council was requested to conduct a public hearing to consider the use of parkland for the temporary use of approximately 1,870 square feet of indoor space within the Turner Roberts Recreation Center for the purpose of providing temporary health clinic services to the surrounding community (the “Proposed Use”). Turner Roberts Recreation Center is located on dedicated parkland known as Colony District Park; and

WHEREAS, the land being used for the Proposed Use is described in Exhibit A (the “Affected Land”); and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing to be held on February 25, 2016, was given for three consecutive weeks on January 31, February 7, and February 14, 2016, in a newspaper of general circulation; and

WHEREAS, such public hearing was held February 25, 2016, by the City Council to consider the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Having taken into account clearly enunciated local preferences, the City Council finds that there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use and that all reasonable planning has been done to minimize harm to the Affected Land from the Proposed Use. The use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use is approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The City Manager is authorized to take such measures as may be necessary, favorable, or required to effectuate the purpose and intent of this resolution.
