GREATER AUSTIN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE'S MOTION TO INTERVENE

This Motion to Intervene ("Motion") is being filed by GREATER AUSTIN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE (the "Party"). The Party is an Austin Energy customer and is entitled to be an intervenor in this proceeding.

The Party has reviewed Austin Energy's Tariff Package and believes that the Impartial Hearing Examiner should address the following issues:

- (1) Meeting the Austin City Council's affordability policy for Austin Energy, approved on February 17, 2011, and reaffirmed on August 28, 2014, which calls for Austin Energy to "operate so as to control all-in (base, fuel, riders, etc.) rate increases to residential, commercial, and industrial customers to 2% or less per year, and to maintain AE's current all-in competitive rates in the lower 50 percent of Texas rates overall, and underscores that the policy direction stated in this resolution is subject to the expectations that the affordability goal will remain in place."
- (2) The equitable application of the cost of service to all rate classes, with special attention to the Commercial Classes as they pay a disproportionate amount of Austin Energy's cost of service.
