
GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF CENTRAL TEXAS' MOTION TO INTERVENE

This Motion to Intervene ("Motion") is being filed by GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF CENTRAL TEXAS (the "Party"). The Party is an Austin Energy customer or is an association which represents Austin Energy customers and is entitled to be an intervenor in this proceeding.

The Party has reviewed Austin Energy's Tariff Package and believes that the Impartial Hearing Examiner should address the following issues:

- (1) Equitable cost of service to all classes, but specifically to the Commercial Class, which pays a disproportionate amount of the utility's costs.
- (2) Deliver an analysis and justification of excessive energy costs given that Austin Energy (AE) commercial rates are out of line with the rest of ERCOT.
- (3) Review the excessive gap in commercial rates between AE and Texas entities; the General Fund Transfer methodology and budgeting for other services; compare and bring into line with other utilities around the state whose return to stakeholders is closer to 7.5% of net profit.
