Here is the application as requested (attached).

The windows were in poor shape and there was a mix:

- 1- A new type in the front South / West corner probably from the 80's (?). Very visible and definitely not matching.
- 2- Fixed glass in the South. Probably from the 50's.
- 3- Garden window in the kitchen.
- 4- Old wood windows everywhere else.

All the windows were in bad shape (leaking, rotting, etc...). So we replaced them with high quality wood windows and we tried to match a historical look as much as possible.

We have used the tax exemption to keep the property in top shape and keep the original look. We have had many people comment on how great the house looks and how it exemplifies the Old Enfield feel.

I would be very happy to drop by your office and discuss further. In addition, we would like to start a permit process to install a two cars carport.
