### Subject

Authorize award and execution of a 36-month contract with ALL POINTS INSPECTION SERVICES, INC. (MWBE /FB), for smoke testing, cleaning, televising and point repair of sanitary sewer collection system pipes, in an amount not to exceed \$956,478, with two 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$318,826 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,594,130.

### Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$159,413 is available in the Fiscal Year 2015 – 2016 Operating Budget of Austin Water. Funding for the remaining 24-months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

### Fiscal Note

There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

### Additional Backup Information

The contract will provide smoke testing, cleaning, televising, and point repair of sanitary sewer collection system pipes ranging from 4" to 36" in the West Bouldin, East Bouldin, and Blunn Creek wastewater drainage basins as well as other areas within the Downtown Austin Project Coordination Zone. The cleaning process will remove sludge, roots, grease, grit, solids and other debris from the wastewater pipes and adjacent manholes. The contractor will remove the debris from the collection system and not allow it to travel downstream. All solids will be transported and dumped by the Contractor to roll-off containers at the City's Walnut Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant. The contractor will place a camera into the lines once they have cleaned sewer mains and code any defective conditions in the mains for point repair if required.

There is no existing contract at this time but once approved work could begin at any time.
