PROPOSAL

Demolish a ca. 1948 house that is non-contributing to the historic district and construct a two-story house in its place.

PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS


The proposed house will be two stories in a neo-traditional style, with a primarily front-facing gabled roof, painted artisan siding, and a combination of double hung and casement windows. The roof will be metal; there will be a side-gabled porte-cochere to the left of the principal entry, and the house will have a front-gabled independent porch.

STANDARDS FOR REVIEW

The Old West Austin National Register Historic District has no design guidelines for new construction. General design principles for new construction in historic districts call for compatibility with the contributing houses in the district in terms of size, scale, materials, and fenestration patterns.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Release the demolition permit and the building permit for the new house. The design of the new house is neo-traditional with materials and a design compatible with the character of the district; many houses along Lorrain and in the immediate area are two stories tall, so the height of this house is also compatible with the character of the historic district.
