BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The City Manager is directed to analyze short term action elements of the Vision Zero Action Plan that will require additional resources. For each such element, the City Manager shall provide an implementation plan for each of the five public safety strategies- Evaluation, Enforcement, Engineering, Education, and Policy- including potential funding plans for each, and report to Council at the August 2, 2016 work session for Council's consideration in anticipation of FY 2016-2017 budget discussions (with longer term action elements to be similarly analyzed through continued work by the City Manager and the Vision Zero Task Force).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The City Manager is directed to analyze existing and emerging transportation practices related to establishment of posted roadway speeds, with equal emphasis between high speed roadways, secondary streets, and neighborhood streets; identify methods and opportunities to reduce posted speed limits (especially in neighborhoods, and potentially as pilot project studies); and present a report on October 5, 2016 for consideration by the Council Mobility Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The City Manager is directed to identify cases involving drivers with a suspended license involved in accidents resulting in injury or loss of life, analyze existing and emerging enforcement and prosecution practices related to those identified suspended license cases, and present a report to Council Health and Human Services Committee and Council Public Safety Committee by no later than October 2016.
