**WHEREAS,** On May 23, 2016, the City of Austin Public Safety Committee met and received a staff briefing and invited testimony regarding the potential consolidation of Travis County Emergency Services District #4 with the Austin Fire Department; and

**WHEREAS,** the Public Safety Committee recommended that the City Manager direct the Austin Fire Department to work with Travis County Emergency Services District #4 and related parties (such as Austin Firefighters Association, Austin African American Firefighters Association) on a Contract for Services that includes but is not limited to financial impact, impact on service delivery, asset transfer, automatic aid, and impact on workforce diversity; and


**WHEREAS,** the Public Safety Committee recommended that the City Manager direct the Austin Fire Department to report back to the Public Safety Committee by July 22, 2016; **NOW THEREFORE**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

The City Manager is directed to have the Austin Fire Department work with Travis County Emergency Services District #4 and related parties (such as Austin Firefighters Association, Austin African American Firefighters Association) on the Contract for Services that includes but is not limited to financial impact, impact on service delivery, asset transfer, automatic aid, and impact on workforce diversity,

and report back to the Public Safety Committee by September 22, 2016. If the report is finished earlier, it will be brought forward as soon as possible.
