## Additional Backup Information

- This interlocal provides for administrative coordination and instruction services performed by TEEX.
- The purpose of this interlocal is for TEEX to provide the City with paramedic training to support the growth and advancement of EMS personnel.
- TEEX provides accredited EMS education that includes paramedic courses designed for non-traditional students.
- TEEX allows for the provision of courses locally and accommodates scheduling classes according to the needs of the EMS Department.
- This flexibility will allow us to provide paramedic training for entry-level sworn employees in order for them to obtain required certifications for advancement in the EMS Department.
- The fees will cover TEEX paramedic course tuition fees for approximately 15 employees.
- The total fee associated with this scope of work is a total contract amount not-to-exceed \$50,000.
