**Request**: Review and consider for recommendation the environmental aspects of the proposed Planned Unit Development (PUD), including code modifications and environmental superiority. **Staff Recommendation:** Recommended with conditions.

The motion to extend the meeting beyond 10pm was approved on Commissioner Peggy Maceo's motion and on Commissioner Linda Guerrero's second. Vote 10-1. Commissioner Hank Smith was absent.

Commissioner Richard Grayum's made a motion with a second from Commissioner Andrew Creel to recommend approval of The Grove at Shoal Creek Planned Unit Development as environmentally superior but not parkland superior, with the conditions from staff and two conditions from the Environmental Commission to install underdrains on the downstream side of all roadways adjacent to Idlewild and to allow the 20 foot greenbelt behind 45<sup>th</sup> Street be used as an alley, as well as a greenbelt, for residents on 45<sup>th</sup> Street. This motion failed due to an approved substitute motion.

The substitute motion made by Commissioner Peggy Maceo with a second from Commissioner Mary Ann Neely recommended denial of The Grove at Shoal Creek Planned Unit Development due to a lack of environmental superiority. Vote 6-4-1. Commissioner Hank Smith was absent.
