MODIFICATION REQUESTED: The applicant has requested a modification to allow a F.A.R. increase from the maximum development permitted in Chapter 25-2 of the Land Development Code, Section 2.1 Subchapter F: Residential Design and Compatibility Standards from the allowable 2300 sq ft. to 2717 sq ft to remodel and add a 1st & 2nd story addition to a single family residence in a SF3-NP zoning district.

COMMISSION'S DECISION: The public hearing was closed on Commissioner Chuck Mains motion to APPROVE; No Second: Motion Failed Commissioner Karen McGraw motion to DENY Commissioner Mary Ingles second on a 4 to 1 vote. DENIED. (Commissioner Chuck Mains, Nay)

Elections APPROVED.
