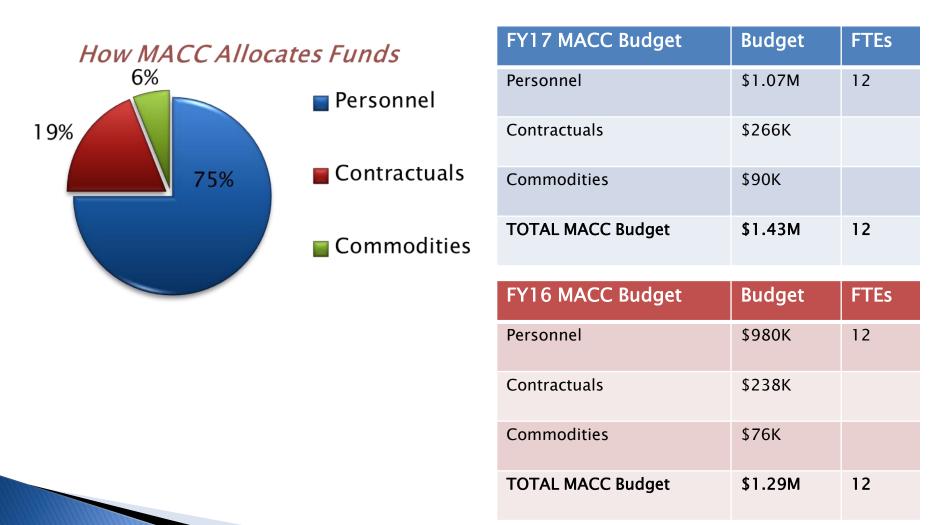

### MACC Net Increase- \$140 thousand\*

#### **Budget Highlights**

#### Personnel

- Employee Insurance, Wage Adjustment Increases, etc. : \$97K
  - Includes temporary grounds maintenance and parking lot attendants

#### Contractuals

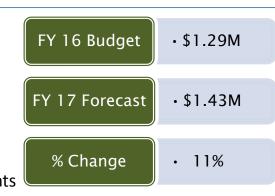
- Equipment Rental, Advertising, Services-other, etc. : \$29K
  - Includes landscaping/shuttle services and video surveillance system

#### Commodities

Software, Office furnishings, etc. : \$14K

Includes one-time funding for a parking booth

\*FY17 Budget includes funding received from parking meter revenue: \$84K

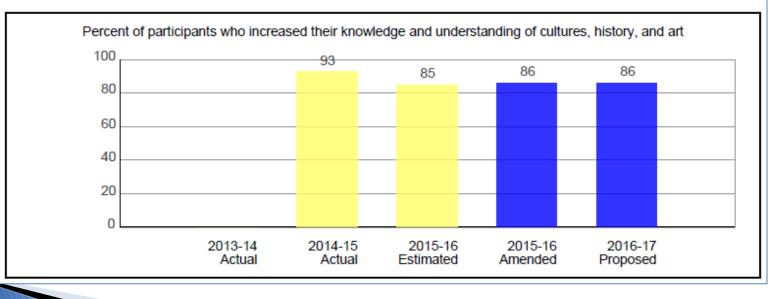
