Chapter 26 of the Parks and Wildlife Code provides that the use of parkland for non-park purposes may be approved upon a finding that there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of this land.

The Department of Public Works requests a use agreement for the construction, operation, and maintenance to construct intersection improvements to the east side of the north bound approach of Lamar Boulevard at 24<sup>th</sup> Street. The improvements to Lamar Boulevard will include an additional northbound left turn lane to reduce congestion. It is presently a four-lane arterial roadway that has been highly congested for a number of years. In the 1998 Bond Program, funding was approved for the reconstruction of Lamar Boulevard at 24<sup>th</sup> Street to alleviate congestion. This project has been specifically identified by City Council as a high priority and is a benchmarked Transportation initiative project. The addition of pavement on the eastside of the existing roadway will improve the intersection alignment and provide space for the addition of a northbound left turn bay. The Tennis Center and the neighboring park system will benefit from the improved roadway and facilitate movement of traffic through the area.

Approval of the use of parkland is made on the condition that all restoration be completed in accordance with the Standard Specifications and Construction Standards of the City of Austin and all restoration in parkland will be completed in accordance with the Parks and Recreation Department's "Construction in Parks Specifications". The requestor is required to pay any and all costs associated with the restoration.

There is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the dedicated parkland that includes all reasonable planning to minimize harm to such lands. The dates of public notification in the Austin American-Statesman will be July 29, August 5 and 12, 2001.
