Resolution About Capital Metro Bus Stops and Bus Service to Zilker Park and Barton Springs Pool

WHEREAS Zilker Park and Barton Springs Pool are major destinations for Austin citizens, especially on weekends, and

WHEREAS Capital Metro Bus 30, which serves Zilker Park and Barton Springs Pool, runs at intervals ranging from 35 to 47 minutes on weekends, even less frequently than it runs on weekdays, and

WHEREAS the bus stops on Barton Springs road in Zilker Park have no shelter from sun or rain and no sidewalks, and only one of the two has a bench to sit on, and

WHEREAS both Zilker Park and Barton Springs road are already filled to overflowing with cars on weekends, and

WHEREAS many low-income people, elderly people, people with children, and people with disabilities depend on the Capital Metro bus for transportation to and from the park, and

WHEREAS it is not easy for people with disabilities or people with small children to use the buses and the bus stops in their present condition, and

WHEREAS the general public could be persuaded to use the bus to visit the park on weekends, if the bus ran more frequently and the bus stops were more comfortable and convenient,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Austin Parks and Recreation Board recommends to the Austin City Council members who serve on the Capital Metro Board that they do all in their power to persuade Capital Metro to accomplish the following.
(1) Add a bus stop to the Bus 30 route, so that the bus stops at the front gate of Barton Springs Pool, instead of dropping pool visitors a quarter mile away on Barton Springs Road.
(2) Provide more frequent bus service to and from Barton Springs pool on Weekends, from 6 AM to 10 PM , giving consideration to bus service every 10 minutes during peak times at the pool facility, and particularly address the need for greater bus service to Zilker Park on Sundays.
(3) Increase bus frequency on weekdays, giving consideration to bus service Every 20 minutes during peak hours.
(4) Provide both bus stops on Barton Springs Road with shelters, benches, and bicycle racks (available free from the City of Austin Bicycle Program).
(5) Provide a sidewalk or a granite gravel trail connecting the bus stops with the hike and bike trail.
(6) Upgrade the bus stops and bus service at McBeth Recreation Center, as recommended by the Board of McBeth Recreation Center.

# Parks and Recreation Board Resolution Supporting City Historic Landmark Designation for Deep Eddy 

WHEREAS, Deep Eddy is an important historic park containing Deep Eddy pool and bathhouse, facilities that have been used and enjoyed by generations of Austinites; and

WHEREAS Deep Eddy qualifies as a City Historic Landmark based upon its 99 plus year history as a publicly accessible swimming and bathing hole, its progressive 1935 bath house design and Depression-era assisted construction, and its cultural and historical significance as a community recreation grounds; and

WHEREAS, designation as a city historic landmark would preserve the park's historic features, such as the bath house and pool for future generations of Austinites; and

WHEREAS historic landmark designation would not restrict the use of the park but would provide design review and guidance for physical changes; and

WHEREAS historic landmark designation would make the park eligible for federal, city and private historic preservation grants for restoration work, particularly for the much needed expeditious restoration of the bath house;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Parks and Recreation Board supports City Historic Landmark Designation for Deep Eddy, recommends that the Planning Commission and the City Council approve this designation for Deep Eddy and that the City of Austin pursue historic grants for the preservation of Deep Eddy and restoration of the bath house.
