A request has been received from Jill and Steve Fooshee to construct a boat dock at 4418 Rivercrest.

The Parks and Recreation Department (PARD) staff has reviewed plans for the proposed project and finds they do not meet the requirements of Article XIII, Section 25-2-1176, Part D (Requirements for the Construction of Boat Docks) of the Land Development Code. The property has an existing one-slip boat dock. The proposal is to add an additional slip. A variance to exceed 20% of shoreline is required and a variance to construct a dock within the 10' of the side property line. A site plan exemption was given to Steve Fooshee in July of 2000. The site plan exemption allowed the replacement of rotten wood as needed, with no replacement of piers or beams for an additional slip. Pillings were installed and an additional slip was added. The property was then red tagged.

RECOMMENDATION:

I do not recommend the approval of the above request as detailed in the attached site plan.

Re: Fooshee Site Plan Extension Request

Dear Members of the Parks Board:

In the summer of 2000, the City of Austin received a Site Plan Exemption Request for property located at 4418 Rivercrest Drive. At that time, I was given the duty of assessing the environmental regulations to all applications associated with boat docks that were filed with the City.

The exemption that was filed with the Fooshee site plan exemption included a list of items/tasks requested to be permitted under the exemption request. The list included the replacement of rotting boards and decking, replace and re-installation of a boat lift on a existing structure located on Lake Austin.

Upon receiving the site plan exemption request, I conducted an on-site visit with Mr. Randy Scott as was our typical protocol for exemptions and site plan applications. When we found the structure, we saw the maintenance was needed on some walkways and other portions of the structure. The "boat lift" was non-existent. At that time I made the determination that the exemption would cover all work except the work associated with the boat lift. Any proposed work on a boat lift would require a separate development application (filing an application did not guarantee approval). Randy Scott and I modified the applicant's request list to clarify that the boat lift was not included in our exemption approval and would require a separate application.



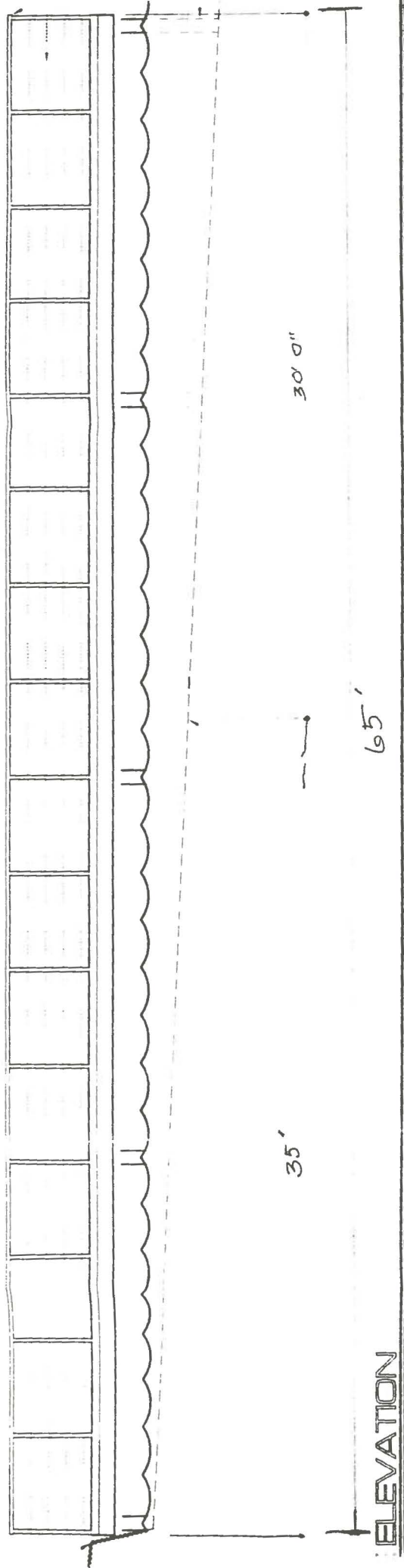

A request has been received from Gene Lucas on the behalf of R. G. JR Mueller to construct a boat dock on Lake Austin.

The Parks and Recreation Department (PARC) staff has reviewed plans for the proposed project and finds they do not meet the requirements of Article XIII, Section 25-2-1176, (Regulations for the Construction of Boat Docks) of the Land Development Code. The proposed dock extends 65' from the shoreline. The location of the proposed dock is just East of the 360 bridge on the North shore. This is the highest traffic area on the lake. A dock may not extend more than 30' from the shoreline unless the Parks and Recreation Board determines that the dock will not create a hazard and approves the construction of the dock. The Parks and Recreation Board shall make a recommendation on the distance a dock can extend without creating a hazard.


