## Subject

Authorize award and execution of a 24-month contract with RUSH TRUCK CENTERS OF TEXAS, LP DBA RUSH TRUCK CENTER, AUSTIN to provide repairs and associated parts for steering, suspension, and alignment services for medium and heavy-duty vehicles and equipment in an amount not to exceed \$431,776, with four 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$215,888 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,295,328.

## Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$35,981 is available in the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Operating Budget of Fleet Services. Funding for the remaining 22 months of the original contract period and extension options are contingent upon available funding in future budgets.
