

**RESOLUTION NO. 20160804-055**

**WHEREAS**, the Building and Standards Commission was expanded to two panels in Ordinance No. 20141211-204, which became effective on July 1, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, the backlog in the Commission's caseload was primarily due to an inability to consistently meet quorum requirements, not because of the number of cases; and

**WHEREAS**, Panel 2 of the Building and Standards Commission has not met since its inception, and currently has only 3 members appointed by Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Panel 1 of the Building and Standards Commission has met consistently throughout 2016, meeting quorum, and has resolved the previous backlog; and


**WHEREAS**, moving forward, one panel of the Building and Standards Commission is sufficient to address the caseload; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

The City Manager is directed to draft an ordinance that reduces the size of the Building and Standards Commission to one panel of 11 members. The City Manager is further directed to present the draft ordinance to Council for its consideration at its September 1, 2016, meeting.
