**PROPOSAL**

---

Demolish a ca. 1925 house.

---

**ARCHITECTURE**

---

One-story, rectangular-plan, side-gabled frame house with a partial-width, shed-roofed independent porch, now enclosed as a front room; single 1:1 fenestration.

---

**RESEARCH**

---

The house appears to have been built around 1925 but was vacant until around 1928, when it was rented by Herman and Lucille White. Neither Herman nor Lucille White had an occupation listed in the city directories, and they lived here with Katie White, a widow, who also had no occupation listed. Katie White is listed as the renter of this house from the late 1920s until around 1946. She did not list an occupation in the city directories, but census reports show that she was a washerwoman for private families. Her daughter, Roberta Harris, who lived here with her mother for many years, took over the occupancy of the house from around 1950 to around 1970. Roberta Harris was a teacher at Kealing Junior High School, then worked as a maid in her later years.

**STAFF COMMENTS**

---

The house is listed in the Comprehensive Cultural Resources Survey (1984) but without a priority for preservation.

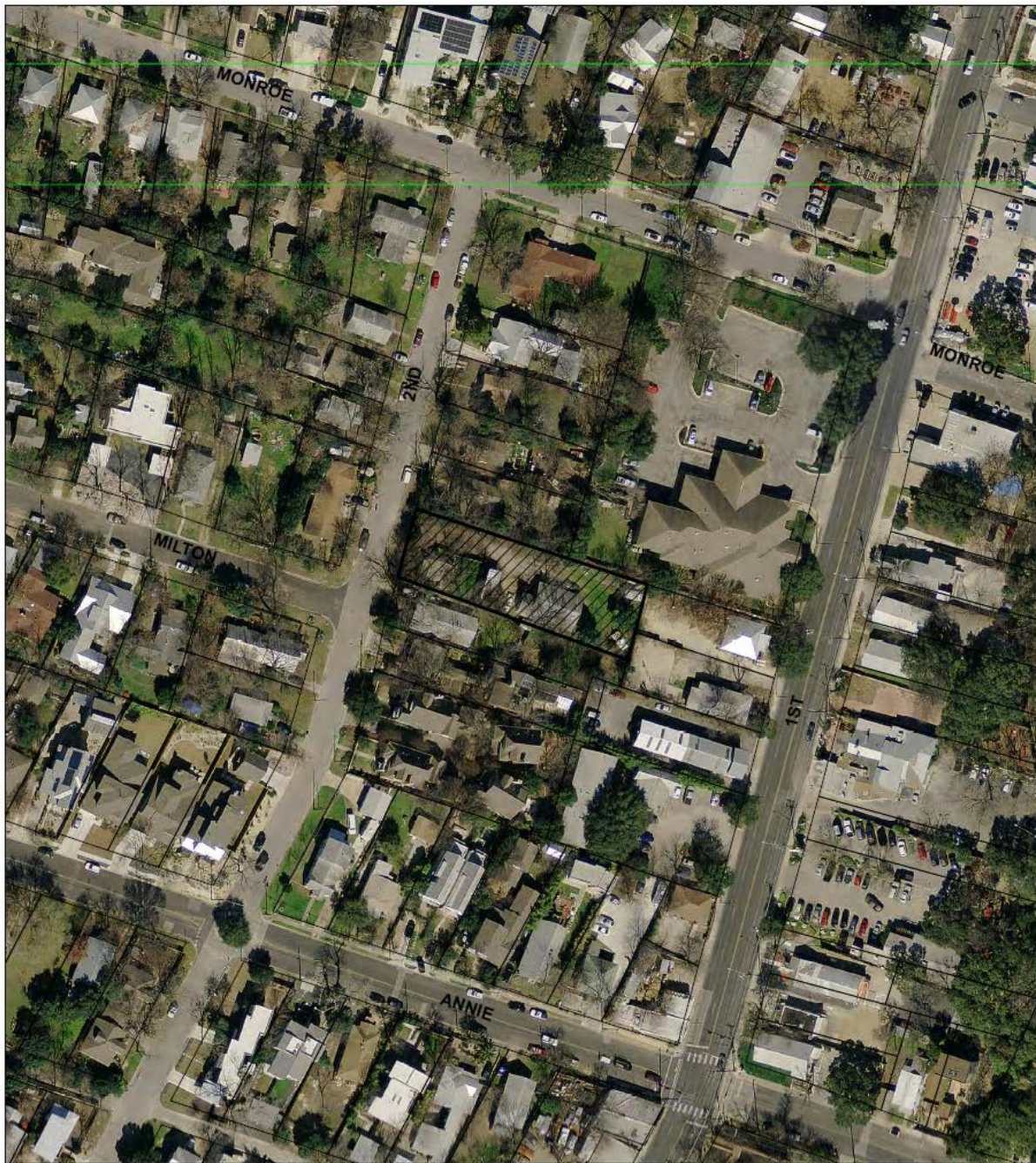
---

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

---

Encourage rehabilitation and adaptive re-use, but release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package, consisting of photographs of all elevations, a dimensioned sketch plan, and a narrative history, for archiving at the Austin History Center. The house, while having associations with the African-American settlement in South Austin, has been greatly modified over the years and no longer retains its integrity of materials or design.

## **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES**

### **Katie White (ca. 1928 – ca. 1946)**

The 1940 U.S. Census lists Katie White as the renter of this house. She was a 73-year old Texas-born widow with no occupation listed. With her lived her daughter, Roberta Sorrells, a 56-year old Texas-born widow who worked as a cook for a private family, and two grandchildren: Johnny White, 12, and Thurlow White, 11.

The 1930 U.S. Census shows Katie White as the renter of this house. She was a 59-year old Texas-born widow who worked as a laundress for a private family. With her lived her daughter, Roberta Sorrells, 39, a divorced baby nurse for a private family. The household also included two grand-children, Katherine Alexander, 15; and Hubert White, 23, who had been born in Texas and worked odd jobs.

The 1920 U.S. Census shows Katie White living with Melvin and Sadie Battle (who later bought the house next door at 1617 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street) on a farm on the Austin-Lockhart Road. Katie White is listed as a washerwoman. She was Sadie Battle's mother.

Katie White was the mother of Roberta Harris, who lived here from around 1950 to around 1970. Katie White's maiden name was Sneed.

### **Roberta Harris (ca. 1950 – ca. 1970)**

According to her 1974 death certificate, Roberta Harris was born in 1895 in Texas, and was living at 1300 Greenwood Avenue at the time of her death. She was a widow who worked as a domestic in private homes. See above for census report information, where she is listed with her mother, Katie White.
