

- 2. The Task Force shall be comprised of 183 members appointed by the City Council:
 - 2 members of the music industry; one nominated by the Music Commission and one nominated by the Economic Opportunity Committee;
 - 2 members of the arts community; one nominated by the Arts Commission and one nominated by the Economic Opportunity Committee;
 - 2 members of the special events industry; one nominated by the Parkland Events Task Force and one nominated by the Economic Opportunity Committee;
 - 1 member nominated by the Austin Convention and Visitors Bureau;
 - 1 member of the hotel industry nominated by the Economic Opportunity Committee:
 - 1 member of the public safety community nominated by the Public Safety Commission;
 - 1 member of the preservation community nominated by the Historic Landmark Commission:
 - 1 member of the parks community nominated by the Parks & Recreation Board;
 - 1 member of the technology community nominated by the Community Technology and Telecommunications Commission; and
 - 1 member nominated by the Downtown Commission.
 - 2 community members who represent the tourism workforce nominated by the Economic Opportunity Committee

 1 community member appointed by the Planning and Neighborhood committee

 - 1 member of the Urban/Transportation Commission nominated by the board
 - 1 member of the Environmental Commission nominated by the board
- 3. A quorum for the conduct of business is a majority of Task Force members. The Task Force shall elect a chair and vice-chair at its first meeting.
- The Task Force will be subject to the Open Meetings Act, all meetings will be open 4. to Public, and public will be given a reasonable amount of time to provide input.
- 5. The City Manager shall provide reasonably necessary resources and technical assistance to the Task Force.
- 6. Any City Council Member may recommend nominees for consideration to the Economic Opportunity Committee no later than October 9th 2016.
- The City Council shall determine whether to dissolve the Task Force or make it a permanent Commission no later than adoption of the Task Force Report or December 31, 2017, whichever occurs first.
- 7-8. It is recommended that staff from Public Works and Austin Transportation Department be included in the working group

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
