





### **BACKGROUND**

The site came in for a boat dock but a site visit revealed large retaining walls on-site. After further investigation, staff determined that the walls did not have a permit.

This variance is sought to permit the fill greater than 4' that is associated with the unpermitted walls.








# LDC 25-8-342(A)

Prohibits fill over four feet. Administrative variances are allowed in Urban and Suburban watersheds up to eight feet but not in a Water Supply watershed or within 100' of a classified waterway.

## **VARIANCE REQUEST**

 Allow fill greater than 4 feet up to 9.6 feet associated with the existing retaining walls.

#### **Similar Cases**

 No. A neighboring site is under environmental enforcement due to unpermitted fill and retaining walls, but they have not yet sought permits for the walls.

# VARIANCE RECOMMENDATION

Since the variance does not meet the Findings of Fact Environmental Review staff is not making a recommendation for this project. However, the Environmental Officer recommends approval of the variance with conditions listed below:

- -Add wave abatement along the entire bulkhead in accordance with ECM 1.13.
- -Remove the steps from the lake.
- -Restore the floodplain on the lower terrace of the site.
